RESOLUTION NO. 23-633

A RESOLUTION THAT APPOINTS THE CITY CLERK, AND IN THEIR ABSENCE THE DEPUTY CITY CLERK, AS THE AGENT TO RECEIVE CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES FOR THE CITY OF QUINCY; REVOKES PRIOR APPOINTMENTS; AND DIRECTS THE CITY CLERK TO RECORD THIS RESOLUTION WITH THE GRANT COUNTY AUDITOR.

WHEREAS, RCW 4.96.020 requires that the governing body of each local governmental entity to appoint an agent to receive claims for damages that are brought under Chapter 4.96 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the identity of the agent that is appointed and the address where the agent may be reached during the normal business hours of the local governmental entity are public records and are required to be recorded with the auditor of the county in which the entity is located pursuant to RCW 4.96.020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously appointed an agent but that agent is no longer employed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, as the governing body of the City of Quincy, desires to appoint the individual that is serving as the City Clerk (and in their absence the Deputy City Clerk) to be the agent that is to receive claims for damages on behalf of the City.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF QUINCY, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by this reference and made part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Appointment. Pursuant to RCW 4.96.020, the City Council hereby appoints the City Clerk as the agent to receive claims for damages on behalf of the City that are brought under Chapter 4.96 RCW. In the City Clerk's absence, the Deputy City Clerk shall

serve as the agent to receive claims for damages on behalf of the City. The City Clerk and the Deputy City Clerk may be reached during the City's normal business hours at the following:

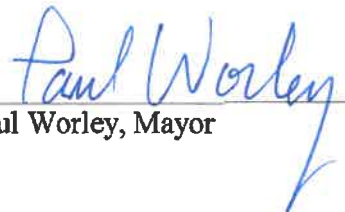
Section 3. Directive. The City Clerk is hereby directed to record this Resolution with the Grant County Auditor within five business days of this Resolution being adopted.

Section 4. Revocation. All prior appointments to receive claims for damages on behalf of the City that are brought under Chapter 4.96 RCW are hereby revoked.

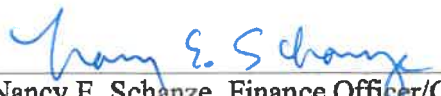
